The 4<sup>th</sup> International Space Arts Workshop (ISAW4) - May 20 -22, 2013**

**SAN FRANCISCO, CA (May 2, 2013)** - For three days in May, artists and scientists from several prominent national and international institutions will convene at NASA Research Park in Mountain View, California for the 4<sup>th</sup> International Space Arts Workshop (ISAW4), to discuss and prepare for future collaborative art projects that include space exploration partners and space science technologies. ISAW4 is sponsored by Taksha University in collaboration with the SETI Institute, Singularity University, the STUDIO for Creative Inquiry at Carnegie Mellon and the Zero Gravity Arts Consortium. The event will be open to invited participants, with a special public exhibition that will take place on Monday night, May 20, 7:00 PM at the SETI Institute, 189 Bernardo Avenue, Mountain View, California 94043. Participants in the workshop sessions will include artists, curators, writers on science and technology, NASA and SETI Institute personnel, and international representatives of the space art community. 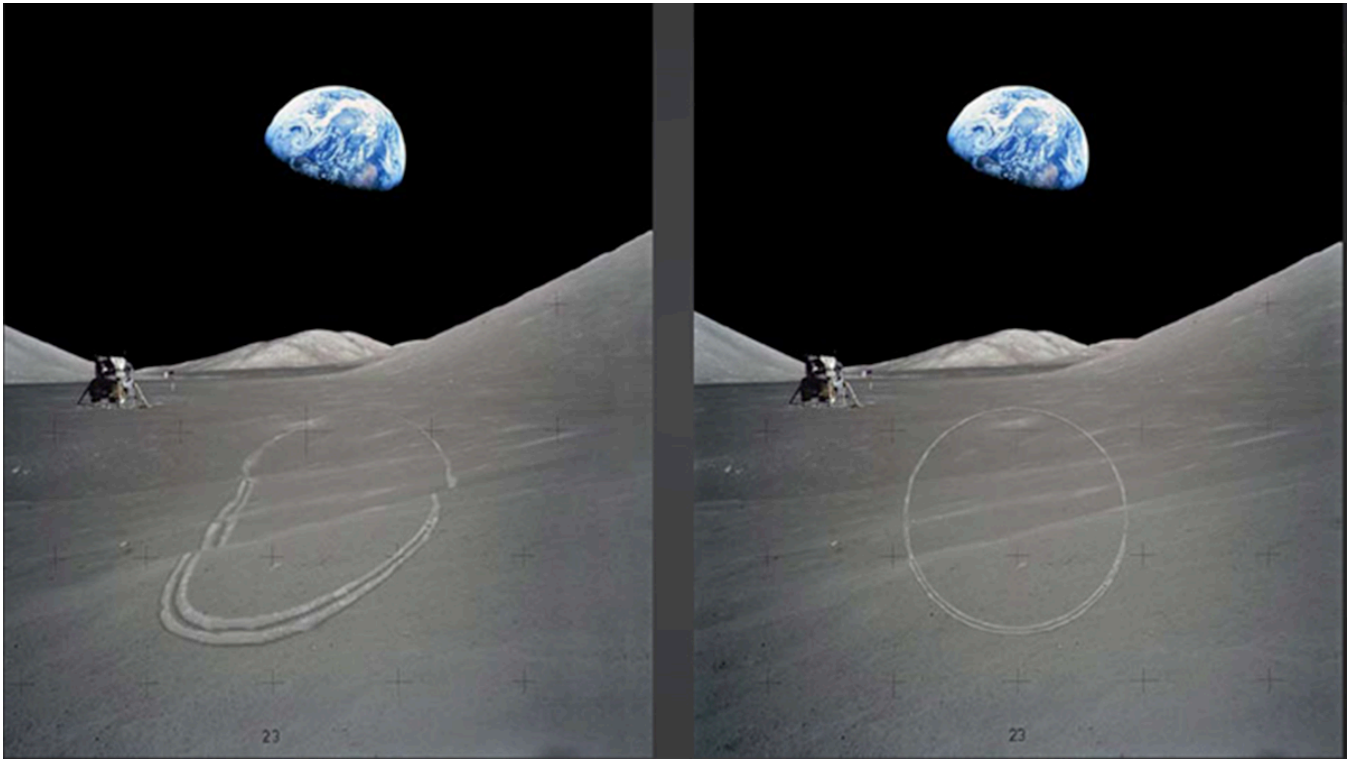
