SAN FRANCISCO, CA (May 2, 2013) - The public is invited to EXPOSITIONS: Space Art on Monday, May 20, 2013, at the SETI Institute in Mountain View, California, at 7:00 to 9:00 pm. This free event will showcase arts in space exploration projects along with dynamic presentations of artists, space scientists and engineers who are participating in a three-day workshop entitled the The 4th International Space Arts Workshop (ISAW4).

The organizers of this event are international activists and advocates for expanding the arts, humanities and culture in space exploration. The event will include presentations on historic videos of cutting-edge arts in space projects, some never seen before in the San Francisco Bay Area. Participants include a gathering of international artists, curators, historians, writers on science and technology, NASA and SETI Institute personnel, and international representatives of the arts in space exploration global communities.

EXPOSITIONS: Space Art is curated by Jean-Luc Soret, Président of Space Art One and Directeur Artistique of the @rt Outsiders International Festival at the European Museum of Photography in Paris, France. This event is one part of a three-day workshop during which artists and scientists from several prominent national and international institutions will convene at the NASA Research Park, Mountain View, California to discuss and prepare for future collaborative works that use, in part, space flight technology. 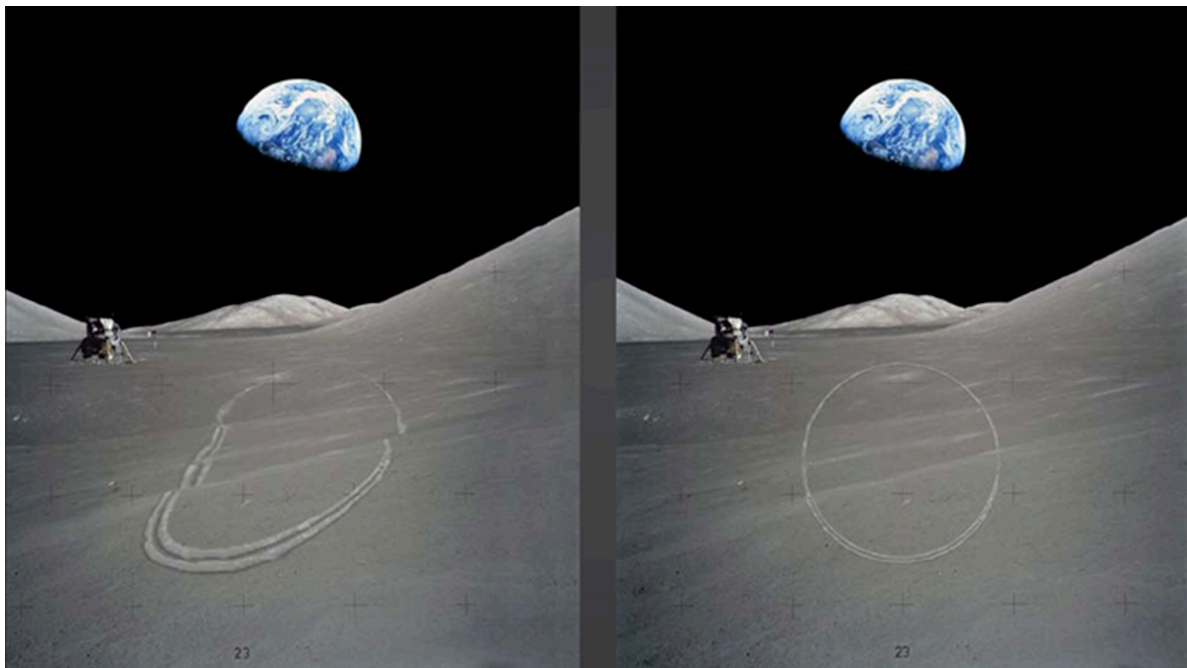
